The Burnett Honors College combines the intimacy of a small liberal arts college with the benefits and academic resources of a metropolitan research university. In classes limited to 20 or fewer students, you'll study, conduct research and connect with a close-knit community of UCF student scholars and expert faculty. The college offers an academically-minded environment where you'll have access to upper-division honors classes, interdisciplinary seminars, service-learning opportunities and additional one-on-one time with faculty and advisors.

- Corporate-sponsored Award, National Merit Scholarship Corporation Award or UCF College-sponsored Award

Non-Florida Residents

The following awards will be stacked and include:

- UCF Merit Scholarship valued at \$80,000*
- Waiver of non-resident fee for tuition
- Corporate-sponsored Award, National Merit Scholarship Corporation Award or UCF College-sponsored Award

All finalists who are first choice designees also receive:

- Expedited admission decision to UCF
- Guaranteed admission to the LEAD Scholars Academy (upon application)
- Guaranteed admission to the Burnett Honors College (upon application) with benefits that include:
 - Priority course registration
 - Special orientation program
 - Access to faculty mentoring






RESEARCH WITH AN IMPACT

Every day at UCF, you can find students and researchers working together to generate real-world impact, improving the lives of our local and global community. For instance, dive into field sites with the Marine Turtle Research Group to study sea turtle nesting spots on Florida beaches and track their movements in the Gulf of Mexico. Research experiences are wide-ranging and on-going in areas like the arts, civics, conservation, cybersecurity, energy, language, health, psychology, sea-level rise, tourism and more.

IMAGINATION IN ACTION

Turn your big ideas into reality with specialized facilities at UCF. Students across all disciplines can gather, conceptualize, test and create in collaborative labs featuring state-ofthe-art technology. This ecosystem of opportunity includes the Texas Instruments Innovation Lab, which is equipped with 3D printers, laser cutters and other high-tech equipment, and a manufacturing lab to finalize prototype designs. The Lockheed Martin Cyber Innovation Lab — which serves as a learning hub, classroom and the practice center for the university's cyberdefense club, Hack@UCF helps hone future leaders in STEM and cybersecurity. And the Games and Interactive Media Makerspace at UCF Downtown (pictured right) provides students with the resources to experiment and create games, websites and interdisciplinary projects.

How can I be considered for a National Merit Scholarship at UCF?

First you must qualify as a National Merit Scholar semifinalist. You should then apply for admission to UCF. National Merit semifinalists are eligible for scholarship consideration.

Students advancing to National Merit finalist standing are eligible for sponsorship as a National Merit Scholar if they **select UCF as their first-choice institution** and adhere to the deadlines specified by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). 
How do I select UCF as my first choice with the NMSC?

Make your selection with the NMSC and be careful to complete all required documentation in accordance with NMSC guidelines and deadlines. If you have questions or concerns, contact NMSC officials at **847.866.5100** or visit **nationalmerit.org**.

How can the National Merit Scholarship be used?

The scholarship may be used in addition to the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, Florida Prepaid College Plans, institutional scholarships, private scholarships and, in some cases, needbased assistance. It will be applied to tuition and fees first, but can also cover part, or all, of the cost of on-campus housing when combined with other awards.

	Check if you are a National Merit semifinalist In September, the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) announces the names of approximately 16,000 semifinalists.
]	Submit your application early in the fall semester. Submit your application online at apply.ucf.edu early in the fall semester. Include a short essay, but don't include the \$30 application fee with your submission. Instead, contact scholarsprogram@ucf.edu or 407.823.6179 to have the application fee waived. UCF also accepts the Common Application. However, the application fee cannot be waived if submitting using this method.

	Complete the NMSC application To be considered for finalist standing, every semifinalist must complete the NMSC application. In addition, your high school must submit an official transcript and a letter of recommendation. The NMSC also requires SAT or ACT scores for consideration.

	Apply for UCF Housing Determine whether to sign an academic or annual agreement housing contract. Then, submit your contract through your myUCF account along with the \$250 prepayment.
]	Apply to the Burnett Honors College To be eligible for the many benefits of the Burnett Honors College, you must submit a completed paper application. No portion of the college's application is waived. All sections must be completed in full (including the essay) and submitted as soon as possible.

Apply to the LEAD Scholars Academy

If you wish to participate in the LEAD Scholars program,

you must submit a completed application by May 31.

Designate UCF as your first-choice institution This is an ongoing process with the first available notification provided in early March and continuing in subsequent notification rounds. If you are "undecided" with the NMSC, the last opportunity to designate UCF as your first choice is May 31. Check if you are a National Merit finalist The NMSC notifies finalists in February. More than 90% of semifinalists advance to finalist standing. All finalists who are Florida residents and designate UCF as their first choice by the NMSC deadline are guaranteed the UCF National Merit Finalist Scholarship. UCF National Merit Finalist Scholarships for non-Florida residents are limited to 30 students. MARCH - JUNE **Select your National Merit Scholarship awards** Beginning in March, the NMSC will offer finalists one of three awards: National Merit-sponsored

All National Merit Scholars receiving a UCF merit scholarship are encouraged to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid to the UCF Office of Financial Assistance every year by **May 1**.

Register for orientation

Orientation registration is available in mid-spring. Go online through your myUCF account to select the orientation session you would like to attend (these also are posted on fye.sdes.ucf.edu/orientation). National Merit finalists are encouraged to attend the honors orientation, however, you may select any orientation to attend.

Submit the UCF enrollment deposit

Submit the \$200 enrollment deposit, which is applied toward your first semester tuition and is not waived as

toward your first semester tuition and is not waived as part of your scholarship, by **May 1**.

Select UCF as first-choice institution by May 31

If you have "undecided" listed as your first choice, you
must designate UCF as your first choice with the NMSC by
May 31, to be guaranteed the UCF merit scholarship award.
