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PROCEDURE

- Apply for and be offered admission to UCF for Fall 2025 by April 1, 2025.
- To apply online, please visit https://www.ucf.edu/admissions/undergraduate/
- Check your admission application status online on your Future Knights Portal <u>https://futureknight.apply.ucf.edu</u> Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarship evaluation.
- Email this completed and signed application form, along with any additional information, to <u>scholarships@ucf.edu</u> by April 15, 2025.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES MUST:

- Have a minimum cumulative 3.5 college GPA by the April 15, 2025 scholarship application deadline.
- Earn an Associate in Arts degree from a Florida public community college or state college by <u>August 18, 2025</u>.
 Articulated and non-articulated AS earned/expected degrees are not eligible.
- Transfer directly to UCF from your Florida public community college or state college.
- Initiate full-time enrollment at UCF beginning Fall 2025. (Summer and Spring applicants will not be considered.)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES DO NOT INCLUDE:

- First Time in College (FTIC) students, state university transfers and/or current UCF students.
- Dual enrollment students earning an A.A. degree and a high school diploma at the same time. These students will be considered for a UCF freshman scholarship based upon their academic credentials.

AWARD:

- \$2,000 to \$4,000 (\$500 to \$1,000 each fall and spring semester for up to 4 undergraduate semesters) toward tuition and fees continuous enrollment and a minimum of 12 UCF semester hours earned each fall and spring required for payment. Transient work, summer credit hours, and non-UCF affiliated programs and coursework do not count toward this requirement. Questions regarding any renewal requirements should be directed to the Office of Student Financial Assistance.
- Scholarship recipients will receive an award letter in late May 2025 and it will contain the specific GPA requirement needed for award renewal.
- The award must begin Fall 2025. <u>This award cannot be deferred to a later semester, you must maintain continuous enrollment at UCF and this award cannot be used for a summer semester.</u>

DEADLINE TO APPLY: Scholarship applications must be received no later than April 15, 2025.
