



Request for Out-of-State Waiver for Florida High School Graduates

Effective July 1, 2025

ELIGIBILITY:

Florida high school graduates who do not meet requirements for Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes, who are U.S. citizens or lawfully present in the United States and meet the following conditions, are eligible for a waiver of out-of-state tuition and fees as dictated by F.S. 1009.26 (12)(a)

1. Attended a secondary school in this state for 3 consecutive years immediately before graduating from a high school in this state;
2. Apply for enrollment in an institution of higher education within 24 months after high school graduation; and
3. Submit an official hard copy Florida high school transcript as evidence of attendance and graduation.

This form is for use by **Florida high school graduates only**. It is not for use for any other waiver offered at UCF.
